## morning drop off


We look forward to welcoming you and your child between 8:50 and 9:00 AM for drop off each day. Please park in our north parking lot and walk your child to the registration station. We ask that you stay with your child until our camp team are ready to receive your child into the program. At registration you will receive a pick-up card that will be required at the end of the day to release your child from camp. Make sure you put those cards somewhere safe and accessible for end of day pickup!

## afternoon pick up

After a fun-filled day of camp, your child will be ready to be picked up at 4:00 PM. We ask that you arrive promptly and follow posted directional signs to our pickup location. You will be asked to show your pickup card in order for our camp team to release our campers to you. If you make arrangements for someone to pick up your child on your behalf it is very important that they have the pick up card in order for our team to release your child to their care.

#### mid-day pick up

Mid-Day Pick Up: Should your child need to be picked up early, please mention this at the registration station when dropping your child off or call the church office at (905)387-5385. When you arrive to pick up your child, please come to the church office (located at Door 1) and one of our camp staff will bring your child to you.
