#### **Sermon Questions**

- 1. What was the main focus of the sermon? How might you summarize it in your own words?
- 2. Share the point (idea/sentence) from the message that most hit home for you.
- 3. How might you live that truth out in your life this week?
- 4. What needs to change in your thinking or practice to apply this truth to your life?

Live out the 'one anothers': Pray for one another, plan times for fellowship as a group or with someone from your group, share with one another in meeting the practical needs you may have within your group.

# 4. Witness (joining Jesus in his mission):

The summer months, with their warmer weather and longer daylight hours, afford us opportunities to invite others to our home or on outings, to share life with our neighbours, and to have unhurried conversations with those outside of our church.
