

We currently have two ruling elders and two deacons. John Fry has served as Ruling Elder since 2011, and Rob McKenzie has served since 2014. Matt Anema became a Deacon in 2005, and Jed Bennett has been a deacon since 2018.

Our History



Westminster was organized on April 15, 1951 by a group of Christians who sought a congregation where God and his Word would be front and center in all the life of the church. They worshipped in a church building in Westchester IL, outgrew it, building a larger chapel, also in Westchester.

During the 1990s, the congregation faced both personal and financial challenges. The building was sold, and the proceeds were invested to provide resources to support ongoing ministry. For the first two decades of the 21st century, the congregation rented a church building in Indian Head Park. Since 2022, it has met for worship in Hope Lutheran Church on Joliet Road in Countryside.

Our present pastor, Robert Tarullo, began his ministry in August of 2012. The Lord has blessed the church to become self-supporting, and we are now hoping to use the investment funds to best pursue our mission and vision.

- Worship location is in a gymnasium


Opportunities

Evangelist Job Description
