

# Call to Worship - Psalm 15

Who Shall Dwell on Your Holy Hill? A Psalm of David.

- [1] O LORD, who shall sojourn in your tent? Who shall dwell on your holy hill?
- [2] He who walks blamelessly and does what is right and speaks truth in his heart;
- [3] who does not slander with his tongue and does no evil to his neighbor, nor takes up a reproach against his friend;
- [4] in whose eyes a vile person is despised, but who honors those who fear the LORD; who swears to his own hurt and does not change; [5] who does not put out his money at interest and does not take a bribe against the innocent. He who does these things shall never be

moved.
