Call to Worship – Psalm 27:1-7

[1] The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

[2] When evildoers assail me to eat up my flesh, my adversaries and foes, it is they who stumble and fall.

[3] Though an army encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war arise against me, yet I will be confident.
