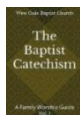

[1] Oh come, let us sing to the LORD; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!
[2] Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!
[3] For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.
[4] In his hand are the depths of the earth; the heights of the mountains are his also.
[5] The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land.
