[1] Clap your hands, all peoples!

Shout to God with loud songs of joy!

[2] For the LORD, the Most High, is to be feared, a great king over all the earth.

[3] He subdued peoples under us, and nations under our feet.

[4] He chose our heritage for us, the pride of Jacob whom he loves. Selah

[5] God has gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet.
