## Call to Worship - Psalms 51:1-12

- [1] Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.
- [2] Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!
- [3] For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.
- [4] Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment.
- [5] Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me.
- [6] Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.
