#### Call to Worship – Psalm 66:1-7

*To the choirmaster. A Song. A Psalm.*

[1] Shout for joy to God, all the earth;

[2] sing the glory of his name; give to him glorious praise!

[3] Say to God, “How awesome are your deeds! So great is your power that your enemies come cringing to you.

[4] All the earth worships you and sings praises to you; they sing praises to your name.” Selah
