Let Us Sing Songs of Praise

- [1] Oh come, let us sing to the LORD; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!
- [2] Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!
- [3] For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.
