

Burnt	Olah – means to ascend or go up. Probably referring to the fact that it was all consumed or burnt like smoke going up to God.	1:1-17	A voluntary gift offered to God for atonement for general sin (inherited sinful nature) and showing devotion and thanks to God.	God: gets everything but the skin Priest: skin Worshiper: None	Accepts offering, collects blood, throws blood onto the sides of the altar, burns on altar	Brings offering, lay hands, slays, skins, cuts into pieces
