Leviticus 10:10 *You are to distinguish between the holy and the common, and between the unclean and the clean, (ESV)*

The parallel between "holy" and "clean" (and "common" and "unclean") reveals that the command was related to one's spiritual condition, though physical actions were often involved.

Purpose of Leviticus

- 1) Atonement is the center of Leviticus, center of Pentateuch, and thematically central to the whole bible.
- 2) Because it is a key to our understanding the major theme and purpose of God throughout the Bible.
 - A) **THEME:** *God is opening a way for humanity to dwell in the presence of God.*
- 3) It helps us feel the weight of sin
 - A) Points to the magnitude of Christ's provision for us on the cross

Leviticus 12

The LORD spoke to Moses saying Speak to the people of Israel saying If a woman conceives



Purification time = 33 days



Purification time = 66 days

"And when the days of her purifying are completed, whether for a son or for a daughter, she shall bring to the priest at the entrance of the tent of meeting a lamb a year old for a burnt offering, and a pigeon or a turtledove for a sin offering,



And if she cannot afford a lamb, then she shall take two turtledoves or two pigeons, one for a burnt offering and the other for a sin offering.
