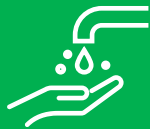
Leviticus 15 Chiasm

1. Long-term (Disease) male discharges
 2. Short-term (normal) male discharges
 3. Male and Female relations together
 2. Short-term (normal) female discharges
1. Long-term (Disease) female discharges

Purpose of Leviticus

- 1) Atonement is the center of Leviticus, center of Pentateuch, and thematically central to the whole bible.
- 2) Because it is a key to our understanding the major theme and purpose of God throughout the Bible.
 - A) **THEME: God is opening a way for humanity to dwell in the presence of God.**
- 3) It helps us feel the weight of sin
 - A) Points to the magnitude of Christ's provision for us on the cross

Defining Clean and Unclean



"Clean"

A Ceremonial and spiritual designation given by God of being fit to worship Him and able to come into His presence. To be clean was to be considered pure, holy and undefiled.

"UnClean"

A Ceremonial and spiritual designation given by God of being unfit to worship Him and unable to come into His presence. To be unclean was to be considered impure, unholy and defiled. It carried the penalty of death to come into the presence of God this way.

Leviticus 10:10 *You are to distinguish between the holy and the common, and between the unclean and the clean, (ESV)*

The parallel between “holy” and “clean” (and “common” and “unclean”) reveals that the command was related to one’s spiritual condition, though physical actions were often involved.
