### Purpose of Leviticus

- 1) Atonement is the center of Leviticus, center of Pentateuch, and thematically central to the whole bible.
- 2) Because it is a key to our understanding the major theme and purpose of God throughout the Bible.
  - A) **THEME: God is opening a way for humanity to dwell in the presence of God.**
- 3) It helps us feel the weight of sin
  - A) Points to the magnitude of Christ's provision for us on the cross

## Leviticus 26 Blessings and Curses

### **Blessing #1 Seasonal rains V4**

I will give you your rains in their season

the land shall yield its increase

the trees shall yield their fruit.

Your threshing shall last to the time of the grape harvest,

the grape harvest shall last until the time for sowing.

you shall eat your bread to the full

### **Blessing #2 Peace in the land V6**

dwell in your land securely.

I will give peace in the land

I will remove harmful beasts from the land,

the sword shall not go through your land.

You shall chase your enemies, and they shall fall before you by the sword.

Five of you shall chase a hundred,

and a hundred of you shall chase ten thousand,

and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword.

### **Blessing #3 Population increase V9**

I will turn to you and make you fruitful and multiply you

I will confirm my covenant with you

You shall eat old store long kept

you shall clear out the old to make way for the new.

### **Blessing #4 God's presence V11**

I will make my dwelling among you, and my soul shall not abhor you.

I will walk among you and will be your God, and you shall be my people.

### **Curses**

I will visit you with panic,

with wasting disease and fever that consume the eyes and make the heart ache.

And you shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.

I will set my face against you, and you shall be struck down before your enemies.

Those who hate you shall rule over you, and you shall flee when none pursues you.

### **Are you ready to repent #1?**

V18 – And if in spite of this you will not listen to me, then I will discipline you again sevenfold for your sins,

I will break the pride of your power, and I will make your heavens like iron and your earth like bronze. [20] And your strength shall be spent in vain,

for your land shall not yield its increase, and

the trees of the land shall not yield their fruit.

### **Are you ready to repent #2?**

V21 – "Then if you walk contrary to me and will not listen to me, I will continue striking you, sevenfold for your sins.

And I will bring a sword upon you, that shall execute vengeance for the covenant.

And if you gather within your cities, I will send pestilence among you, and you shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy.

When I break your supply of bread, ten women shall bake your bread in a single oven and shall dole out your bread again by weight, and you shall eat and not be satisfied.

### **Are you ready to repent #4?**

V27 – "But if in spite of this you will not listen to me, but walk contrary to me, [28] then I will walk contrary to you in fury, and I myself will discipline you sevenfold for your sins.

You shall eat the flesh of your sons, and you shall eat the flesh of your daughters.

And I will destroy your high places and cut down your incense altars and cast your dead bodies upon the dead bodies of your idols, and my soul will abhor you.

And I will lay your cities waste and will make your sanctuaries desolate, and I will not smell your pleasing aromas.

And I myself will devastate the land, so that your enemies who settle in it shall be appalled at it.

And I will scatter you among the nations, and I will unsheathe the sword after you, and your land shall be a desolation, and your cities shall be a waste.

"Then the land shall enjoy its Sabbaths as long as it lies desolate, while you are in your enemies' land; then the land shall rest, and enjoy its Sabbaths. [35] As long as it lies desolate it shall have rest, the rest that it did not have on your Sabbaths when you were dwelling in it.

And as for those of you who are left,

I will send faintness into their hearts in the lands of their enemies.

The sound of a driven leaf shall put them to flight, and they shall flee as one flees from the sword, and they shall fall when none pursues.

They shall stumble over one another, as if to escape a sword, though none pursues.

you shall have no power to stand before your enemies.

you shall perish among the nations, and the land of your enemies shall eat you up.

And those of you who are left shall rot away in your enemies' lands because of their iniquity, and also because of the iniquities of their fathers they shall rot away like them.
