Purpose of Leviticus

- 1) Atonement is the center of Leviticus, center of Pentateuch, and thematically central to the whole bible.
- 2) Because it is a key to our understanding the major theme and purpose of God throughout the Bible.
 - A) **THEME: God is opening a way for humanity to dwell in the presence of God.**
- 3) It helps us feel the weight of sin
 - A) Points to the magnitude of Christ's provision for us on the cross

Passover	Num. 28:16–25	Two bulls, one ram, seven male lambs a year old shall you offer for a bull, one male goat	grain offering of fine flour mixed with oil 3/10 of an ephah for bull, 2/10 of an ephah for a ram 1/10 of an ephah for each of the seven lambs;	
Feast of Weeks	Num. 28:26–31	Two bulls from the herd, one ram, seven male lambs a year old; one male goat	grain offering of fine flour mixed with oil 3/10 of an ephah for each bull, 2/10 of an ephah for one ram, 1/10 of an ephah for each of the seven lambs	
Feast of trumpets	Num. 29:1–6	One bull, one ram, seven male lambs ram, one male goat	grain offering of fine flour mixed with oil 3/10 of an ephah for the bull, 2/10 of an ephah for one ram 1/10 for each of the seven lambs	
Day of atonement	Num. 29:7–11	One bull, one ram, seven male lambs ram, one male goat	grain offering of fine flour mixed with oil 3/10 of an ephah for the bull, 2/10 of an ephah for one ram 1/10 for each of the seven lambs	
Feast of tabernacles	Num. 29:12–39	Thirteen bulls on day one (12 on day 2, 11 on day 3, 10, 9, 8, 7, 1 on last day = 58 total bulls) two rams each day, 1 on last day = 15 total rams, fourteen male lambs each day = 105 lambs, one male goat each day = 8 total goats	grain offering of fine flour mixed with oil 3/10 of an ephah for each of the 13 bulls = 2.1 total ephahs 2/10 of an ephah for each of the 14 rams = 1.4 total ephahs 1/10 of an ephah for each of the 7 lambs = 7/10 total ephahs
