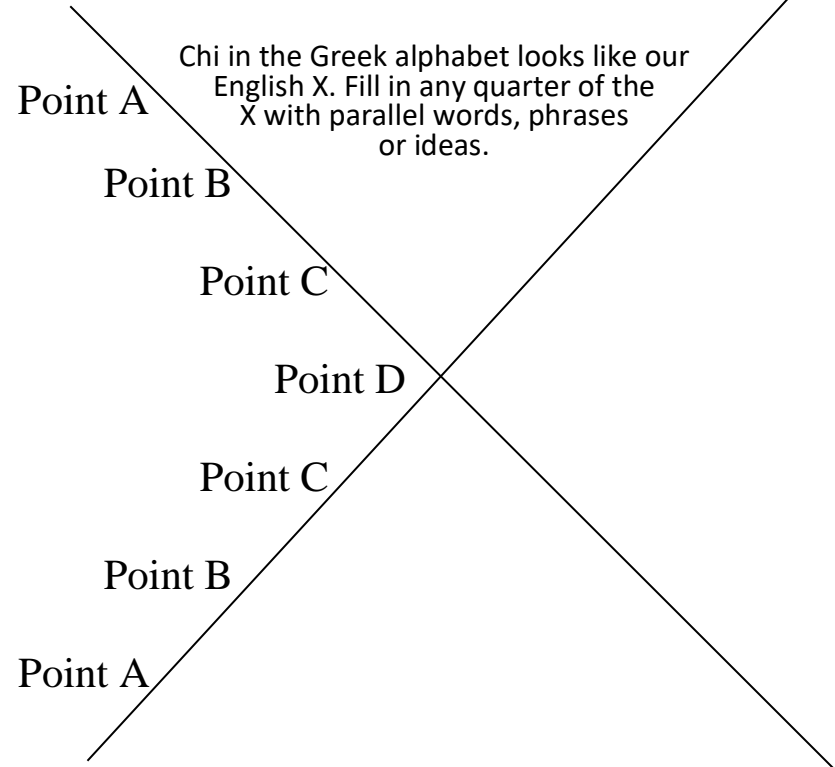

## A.C. Leder Chiasm of the Pentateuch

- (A) Genesis – Separation from the nations / Blessing / Seeing the land / Descendants and the land.
- (B) Exodus – Israel’s desert journeys / Apostasy and plagues / Pharaoh and magicians / First-born / Levites
- (C) Leviticus – Sacrifices / Cleanness / Holiness
- (B) Numbers – Israel’s desert journeys / Apostasy and plagues / Balak and Balaam / First-born / Levites
- (A) Deuteronomy – Separation from the nations / Blessings / Seeing the land / Descendants and the land.

## Moshe Kline Chiasm of the Pentateuch

- (A) Genesis – **Prologue**
- (B) Exodus – **Leaving Egypt / Building the tabernacle**
- (C) Leviticus – **The tabernacle service**
- (B) Numbers – **Dedicating the tabernacle / Preparing to enter Canaan**
- (A) Deuteronomy – **Epilogue**
