How has this teaching time encouraged you to "glory in your baptism"?

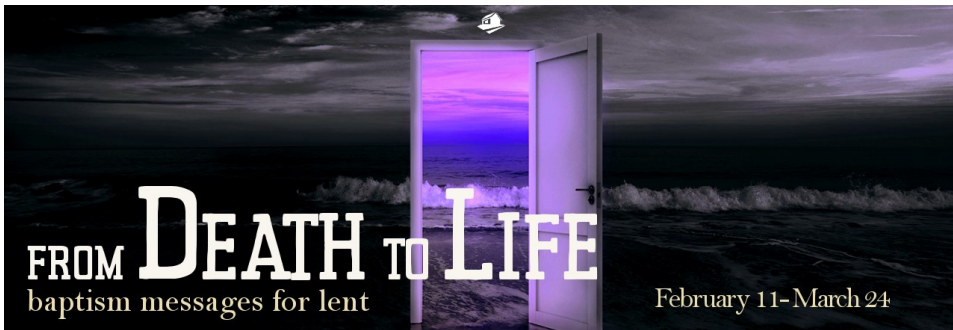
Yes, we are saved by faith in Christ. How would you encourage someone who says they don't need to be baptized taking an oath of allegiance to King Jesus?
