Summary of Session Meeting on September 14, 2015

The Session meets monthly and a portion of the meeting is devoted to continuing education for the officers. The Deacons join the meeting for the continuing education as well as any joint business that comes before us. We are studying a book by R. C. Sproul entitled "What is Reformed Theology?", and we have assigned reading, watch a video segment of Dr. Sproul's lecture, and a period of discussion.

The Session has approved a Child Protection Policy that addresses how child care givers and teachers in the children's programs are to carry out their responsibilities. This policy includes required training in child protection issues as well as a background check through an organization called "Protect My Ministry". Parents can be assured that our care givers have been screened, are aware of their responsibilities and have been trained to provide their children with a safe environment.

The Foreign Missions Committee updated its policies on mission trips, and the updated policies were reviewed and approved by the Session. Your Session has also approved projects such as the new entryway canopy, nursery improvements both in painting, carpet, and equipment, repairs to many of the heating/air conditioning units that were failing, and a sound system, new projector and screen for the FAC.

The Session has also granted up to twelve weeks paid leave absence to Faye Poston in order that she may care for Buddy Poston during his illness. We will continue to evaluate this leave as needed. We warmly welcome Dawn Allen as our office manager during Faye's leave of absence. Dawn is a member of Zion Baptist Church. She and Todd, her husband, have 3 children. Please welcome her as you call or visit the office.




