

## Biblical Fellowship Week 2: The Greatest Obstacle to True Biblical Fellowship

### What leads us to sin?

1. Sin begins when \_\_\_\_\_.
  - a. Romans 1:28-31
  - b. Genesis 3:1-7.
2. Satan's attack is two-fold:
  - a. He first says, "You have the right to judge God, and \_\_\_\_\_."
  - b. He then says, "\_\_\_\_\_."
3. Often, what Satan offers is not inherently bad, but even reflective of God: affirmation, love, security...
4. The sin is that we pursue our idols in a way that \_\_\_\_\_ because we believe we have the right to judge Him as not good.

We often try to address only what we see of our sin, without addressing what drives our sin.
