WORSHIP



We worship by praising our creator God, confessing our sins before Him, confessing our faith, reading the Bible, singing hymns and psalms, and hearing sound, expositional preaching based on and faithful to God's holy and inerrant word. Our music is traditional/classical, featuring organ, piano, and choir, with occasional use of handbells and other orchestral instruments. We have recently made a multi-generational commitment to our music ministry by installing a new 38-rank Schantz pipe organ.

Community Groups


