***CONFESSION OF FAITH
HEIDELBERG CATECHISM #12-15**

Pastor: (Q. 12) According to God’s righteous judgment we deserve punishment both now and in eternity: how then can we escape this punishment and return to God’s favor?

All: God requires that his justice be satisfied. Therefore the claims of this justice must be paid in full, either by ourselves or by another.

Pastor: (Q. 13) Can we make this payment ourselves?

All: Certainly not. Actually, we increase our debt every day.

Pastor: (Q. 14) Can another creature—any at all—pay this debt for us?

All: No. To begin with, God will not punish any other creature for what a human is guilty of. Furthermore, no mere creature can bear the weight of God’s eternal wrath against sin and deliver others from it.

Pastor: (Q. 15) What kind of mediator and deliverer should we look for then?

All: One who is a true and righteous man, yet more powerful than all creatures, that is, one who is also true God.
