## **Missions:**

In Kampala, Uganda, an MTW missionary recently had the privilege of interviewing people who had gone through a church membership class and getting to hear how God had worked in their lives.

Years ago, one of the people had been in a major accident in a mini-van taxi. Out of the 15-plus people involved, he was the only survivor. Then, last year, he moved to the neighborhood where our partner church is located to work on a construction site. Though he’d grown up in a Muslim family, he noticed the church, became curious, and began attending. After hearing a sermon one Sunday, he felt convicted of his sin and expressed his desire to trust in Christ as his Savior to the church’s men’s ministry leader. The pastor and leader prayed with him and encouraged him to go through the membership class. At a subsequent thanksgiving-themed worship service, our missionary baptized him. The church celebrated three other baptisms and a total of 11 new members!
