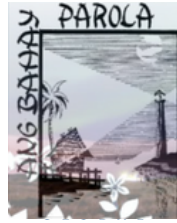

Unity in Trinity

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. – Deuteronomy 6:4

God has revealed himself in his Word as the living and true God. Jeremiah 10:10 states, "But the LORD is the true God; he is the living God and the everlasting King." As our God is the living God, he is distinguished from the dead idols of this world. As our God is the true God, he is distinguished from dead gods this world bows down to. The idols and gods of this world are the work of human hands (cf. Psalm 115:4), but the God of Israel is the infinite, eternal, and unchangeable God of the Scriptures who is to be worshiped in spirit and truth.

WSC Q. 5, Are there more Gods than one?

A. There is but one only, the living and true God.

God has revealed himself as one God in three persons. Herman Bavinck says, "It is only when we contemplate this trinity that we know who and what God is...who God is and what he is for lost mankind." In fact, this is the one doctrine that separates Christianity from every other religion in the world. God is one in his divine being; one in his divine wisdom; one in his divine power; one in his divine glory.

Yet, our God has revealed himself in three persons because this is who he is in his eternal existence. The only thing distinguishing the persons of the trinity are their personal properties: the Father begets the Son; the Son is begotten of the Father; and the Spirit proceeds from both the Father and the Son. This procession of Father, Son, and Spirit is and has always been true of God.

We see this procession most clearly in God's mission to redeem sinners to everlasting life. It's the Father's role to give an elect seed to his Son (John 6:37). It's the Son's role to redeem the Father's elect (John 6:39). It's the Spirit's role to effectually call dead sinners to life and to sanctify them until glory (Titus 3:5).

All that we have come to know of God and how we are to fulfill our chief end is done by the Spirit, through the Son, and to the Father. This is why Jesus taught us to pray, "Our Father..." Coming to our heavenly Father is the single greatest privilege of the Christian, for every one of our prayers is because of the trinitarian work of our God.

Come to the throne of grace with boldness laying your petitions at the feet of your heavenly Father. Pray for the conversion of sinners so that the whole race of mankind would come and worship the one living and true God.

WSC Q. 6, How many persons are there in the Godhead?

A. There are three persons in the Godhead; the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost; and these three are one God, the same in substance, equal in power and glory.
