

Westminster is excited to announce that we will now offer online giving through our website and our Westminster App! Below you will find instructions to set up your account and complete your giving. If you have further questions please call us at the church office (662) 453-7608 and we will be happy to assist you.

Step 1: Visit www.wpcgreenwood.org/giving or touch the 'Give' on the Westminster App


Step2: Type in the amount of your tithe/offering/gift and select the frequency (One-Time, Weekly, Monthly, etc...) then select the 'Next' button.




Step 3: If you have already created an account, simply log in if necessary. If you have not created an account, enter in your information (Name, Email, Create Password) and select 'Sign Up'




Step 4: Check email for your verification code. Once you receive the emailed verification code, enter that code into the box that is provided. If for some reason you did not receive the email, simply select the 'Resend Code?' link on the web page.




Step 5a: Now it is time to link either your bank account or your debit card. We will start with the debit card. Select 'Link debit card' and enter your information. DONE!






Step 5b: In order to link the bank account, select 'Link bank account'. Subsplash will need the following information:




Upon entering the appropriate information, you will receive the following confirmation:



You should receive the micro-deposits in 1-2 days. After receiving the micro-deposits in your account please return to your Subsplash giving account (refer to Step 7 for information on how to return to your account), select 'Payment Methods', and confirm the two deposits that were made.

Step 6: Once you have linked your debit card and/or verified your bank account link, you are ready to give! At this point, simply visit the giving web site or the app and fill out your appropriate information to give. If you need to log in, use the email address and password that you set up.




We have set up three separate funds to give to right now.


- 1. Tithe & Giving

Use the drop-down arrow to select which account you would like to donate to. In the future as different opportunities arise, we will update these options.

Step 7: In the future, if you would like to review your re-occurring gifts, view past gifts, or make changes to your account, return to the Giving Page on the Web Site or visit the 'Give' link on the App. After logging in, look to the upper right-hand corner of the screen and select the silhouette of a person.



After selecting the silhouette, your will see all of your account options.

Finally, as we consider the resources that God has given us to manage in our time on earth, it is always good to remember His Words with regards to giving. A particular excellent summation of the Gospel of generosity is II Corinthians 9:6-15.

- 1. Give generously
- 2. Give cheerfully, not out of compulsion, but out of the overflow of a thankful heart
- 3. God promises to provide for His people
- 4. God's nature is one of generosity.
- 5. Our generosity with earthly possessions is one way that we can reflect glory to God. As our resources are used to help those in need, God's name is praised through the work of His people.
- 6. A final reminder that we are the recipients of the ultimate generosity, God's grace. It is this reality that should stir our hearts to give.

## II Corinthians 9:6-15

The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work. As it is written, "He has distributed freely, he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever."

He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way to be generous in every way, which through us will produce thanksgiving to God. For the ministry of this service is not only supplying the needs of the saints but is also overflowing in many thanksgivings to God. By their approval of this service, they will glorify God because of your submission that comes from your confession of the gospel of Christ, and the generosity of your contribution for them and for all others, while they long for you and pray for you, because of the surpassing race of God upon you. Thanks be to God for his inexpressible gift!
