In this illumination, an enthroned Christ is pictured surrounded by the Four Evangelists - Matthew depicted as a man; John depicted as an eagle; Mark depicted as a lion, and Luke depicted as a bull. The same depictions of the Evangelists adorn Zion's pulpit. They are seen in Ezekiel 1:10 and in Revelation 4:7. The *Vesica Piscina* or *Mandorla* in which our Lord is depicted is an ancient symbol for the Resurrection.
