Cover Art - The Devil Tempts Christ in the Desert

A mosaic in the Monreale Cathedral,
Erected by Norman King William II in 1180 A.✠ D.
Sicily, North of Palermo, on the slope of Mount Caputo

The Latin text surrounding the image reads: "*si Filius Dei es dic ut lapides isti panes... dixit scriptum est non in pane solo vivet homo sed in omni verbo quod procedit de ore Dei*", Matthew 4:3-4 from the Vulgate, which in English reads: "'If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.... 'It is written,'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.'"
